- 1. Call to Order/Announcements- Max Ellis
 - a. Meeting called to order at 7:03 pm
 - b. Board members introduced themselves
 - c. Motion to approve agenda, seconded, motion passes
 - d. Motion to approve Jan. 19th minutes, seconded, motion passes
- 2. Bryan Square Park- Jason Green
 - a. Construction of Bryant square bathrooms are expected to be done in April. HVAC will happen after this. Fencing will be around HVAC units.
 - b. Ice skating rink has been extended through the first part of March. Utilization is 4 times more than typical use.

- 3. Development Committee- Ashley Bredeson
 - a. Strategic Planning
 - i. Met with GVC consulting group last week
 - ii. Entire process will take about 8 weeks
 - iii. Emphasis on community engagement- keep an eye out on email and social media
 - b. New Committee Member
 - i. Zakq Lockrem
 - ii. Lockrem was not present so Bredeson and Engel provided some background about his experience and interest in the committee
 - iii. Motion to add Lockrem to the committee, discussion took place, motion to vote, motion approved
- 4. Livability and Engagement Committee- Christine Beeson
 - a. Typically South Uptown the Chili fest every year, but it was decided that there needs to be a push for fundraising for Joyce food shelf instead. Beeson will put a link to the GiveMN page for the Joyce food shelf in the chat. South Uptown organization is providing a \$1,000 matching grant. Now through February 28th at midnight. The pantry needs diapers size 4, 5 and 6; personal toiletries, laundry detergent, dish soap. Sunday Feb. 28th from 12-2pm is when you can drop off items.

 - i. Main change is neighborhoods will receive baseline funding and extra funds based on metrics. Baseline of \$12,500 and another portion based on measuring engagement with underrepresented groups. In the past received a little over 22,000.
